### **RCM REPORT-**

Region still needs a secretary. Like in our area, this is a very important position as information from regional meetings needs to get out ASAP.

I've given the Regional Treasurer's report to Eric in case someone asks about Regional finances.

### **PR/H&I:**

The committee chair wanted us to know they were very pleased that EANA attended their meeting. It goes a long way when the Areas are on the same page as the region.

I was given a copy of the proposal and after some discussion the following was revealed: The proposal aimed at removing the suggested restrictions to federal institutions (prisons) based on sex. This is because the Federal Gov. is forbidden to discriminate and cannot restrict access to fed. Institutions based on the Charter of Human Rights. Basically the proposal was only to recommend removing this restriction from our guidelines **"if we wanted to"**, not that we **"had to"**. If no males were available to sponsor these institutions and a female was willing and able to fill the position, she would be given the opportunity. This proposal did not intend to force women into male facilities, only to allow them to do so if they wanted to.

### **Helpline:**

Here are just a few statistics to show the importance of the Helpline as well as the impact the Helpline could have on the growth of our fellowship if we put more effort into it.

- Approximately 1390 calls per month
- 94 requests to speak to an Anglophone
- 29 English meeting information requests
- 13 English activity information requests.

The regional HL committee asks that the Anglophone volunteers keep a record of the calls they take so they can pass on the information and that they remember that they are accountable to the service structure.

Also, "The EANA programmer of phone volunteers should remain in tight communication with the French side, to maintain a level of bilingualism and to avoid calls not being returned, to help and not govern on the distribution of the phone line shifts."

**YCNA** will be held at the Montreal Airport Sheraton on March 16-17 & 18, 2012.

**QRCNA:**

Outgoing chair recommended that the guidelines be revised as he feels they are very outdated. The Convention Advisory Committee took note and committed to reviewing them in 2012. Registration will probably remain at \$30 (or more) because they need that money to cover their expenses. Approx 1 out of every 10 people either don't pay full amount or don't pay at all. This said, they still reported a profit of about \$9,000.

QRCNA 25 & 26 will be held in St-Hyacinthe as convention contracts are negotiated for 2 years. QRCNA 27 will most likely be held in Gatineau. They are looking at locations right now. It is not final however.

**CSL OUTAOUAIS (Gatineau)**

Their MCR is asking if EANA would be willing to share any English TV and/or Radio PSAs we might have. Several opportunities have presented themselves for that Area to get better exposure at no cost and they would like to avoid the costs of creating the PSAs, if possible. I have the MCR's e-mail address if we can help them.

**CSL MONTREAL** is working on a proposal to renew their ad in the Metro and/or 24Hr newspapers. They also have several open positions at their ASC table.

Other Areas and committees are doing well.

On a personal note, I would like to point out that one Area made a donation of \$640.00 and another donated \$700.00 to the region. We need to step up in order to help the region with Fellowship Development costs on a regional as well as national level. We can only benefit from it in the long run.

**CAR:** Asked the regional chair about CAR. This will become a communication tool between groups around the world and World Conference. There will be a tour with MCR and on Saturday afternoons. The next one is the last weekend in January and a subsequent one on the last weekend in March 2012. The location is 6120 Lafontaine.
